

APPNA Young Physician Committee Pakistan Medical Graduates Performance in 2024 NRMP® Match



In Oklahoma, our tightly knit community takes great pride in celebrating our heritage and fostering a culture of altruism and societal contribution. Since its establishment in 2016, our local chapter has flourished with a current membership of 96, including 86 esteemed lifetime members. Our chapter has grown tremendously, remains vibrant, and actively engaged in philanthropic endeavors. Throughout the years, we have organized numerous fundraising initiatives, and last year was and this year will be no exception.

- 1. Colon Cancer Awareness Walk: APPNA Oklahoma organized a walk to raise awareness about colon cancer in March of 2023 and 2024. The event aimed to educate the community about the prevention, early detection, and treatment options for colon cancer. Participants walked together to show support for those affected by the disease and to promote a healthy lifestyle. The event has become a platform for community engagement and collaboration among many different entities and a source of pride for our chapter!
- 2. Turkish Earthquake Relief Fundraiser: APPNA Oklahoma conducted a fundraiser to support the victims of the earthquake in Türkiye. These initiatives aimed to provide access to free health screenings, educational resources, and preventive care services. All surgeries were successfully performed on patients free of charge, including at Civil Hospital, Karachi and Al-Shifa Trust Eye Hospital, Pindi. Advanced endothelial or "sutureless" transplant techniques were taught to residents and junior attendings to expedite recovery and visual rehabilitation.



2- A rare Solar Eclipse

Is anyone in America not aware that a rare total solar eclipse will occur on April 8th? A solar eclipse occurs when the moon passes between the Earth and the sun, temporarily blocking out the sun's light. This phenomenon typically happens during the day and can be either partial, total, or annular, depending on the alignment of the sun, moon, and Earth. During a total solar eclipse, the moon completely covers the sun, creating a breathtaking sight as the sky darkens and the sun's corona becomes visible. Solar eclipses are rare events that capture the fascination of people around the world. They provide scientists with opportunities to study the sun's corona and its effects on the Earth's atmosphere. Additionally, solar eclipses have cultural significance in many societies, with various myths, traditions, and rituals associated with them throughout history. It's important to note that viewing a solar eclipse



directly without proper eye protection can cause permanent eye damage. Specialized solar viewing glasses or indirect viewing methods, such as pinhole projectors, should be used to safely observe the eclipse.



This year it will be seen by tens of millions of Americans as it cuts across the United States from Texas to New England before traveling through southeastern Canada and out into the Atlantic Ocean. Grab your solar glasses to watch as darkness spreads across the land.
